Coding for Vaccine Administration - AAFP Home
The administration fee for the DTaP Hib IBV pediatric combination vaccine is billed with CPT code 90698 (diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, acellular pertussis vaccine, haemophilus influenza Type B, and poliovirus vaccine, inactivated [DTaP-Hib-IPV] for intramuscular use) and modifier SL, for use in individuals 6 months through 4 years of age (prior to 5th birthday).

CODING FOR Pediatric Preventive Care2020
The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program was established in 1993 to serve children defined as "federally vaccine eligible" under section 1928(b)(2), which includes both "uninsured" and "Medicaid eligible" children.

Vaccines for Children Policy, Professional
An MMR vaccination consists of three components; 90460 is billed once for the first component with a reimbursement of \$25.51 and +90461 is billed twice (once for each additional component) for a

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reimbursement of \$25.88. This gives a total reimbursement of \$51.39.

Payment, Coding, & Billing . In addition to the vaccine product, offices should be appropriately paid for vaccine administration. The components covered by vaccine administration codes are separate from the product and overhead costs. Proper coding can also help to optimize payment.

For Medicare Part B submissions, physician practices and other mass immunizers must submit a separate preprinted CMS-1500 paper claim form or bill electronically for each type of vaccination (either influenza or pneumococcal) and attach a roster bill containing information for two or more Medicare beneficiaries.
