The earliest pottery marks found on Chinese pottery are from the Qin dynasty (BC248-207), the Han dynasty (BC206-AD220) and the Three Kingdoms Period (220-280). Marks found on Chinese ceramics are significantly different from those on European antique ceramics. In China porcelain marks or pottery marks on antiques had mostly a different purpose and way of expression than those used in the west since at least the 17th or 18th century.

This year Marquis Ory de Fulvy obtained from the king Louis XV a licence to manufacture porcelain.

If the piece of pottery or porcelain you have has a mark on it, you can identify it in several ways. Slavid recommends that you head to the library and look for books on the mark. "But you do need to know the country of origin," he says. "A book on English china marks won't help you find anything about a German pottery mark."

Your Guide to Identifying Pottery and Porcelain Marks ...

Pottery marks and porcelain marks are like silver hallmarks – often difficult to decipher, frequently duplicated with very small variations by other manufacturers, and changing with periods of manufacture and management of the pottery or porcelain factory. Stoneware and earthenware were seldom marked until the late eighteenth century and even some genuine pieces of eighteenth century porcelain are found without makers marks.
