Communicable Disease Notes. When a Communicable Disease is Suspected [] Separate the ill child from well children at the facility until the ill child can be taken home. [] Inform parents immediately so that medical advice can be sought. [] Adhere to the exclusion and readmission requirements provided on this chart.

Communicable Disease Notes. Nuisance Diseases. So-called "nuisance" diseases, such as scabies, head lice (pediculosis), ringworm of the body or scalp, and pinworms are highly contagious and can cause problems in a group-care setting. Children and adults with these conditions (except ringworm of the body and pinworms) should be excluded until treated.
