In content-based instruction as in other experiential communicative language teaching approaches, the traditional second language instructional focus on raising learners' awareness of linguistic form is secondary to a focus on their learning and sharing of information through the medium of the second language, in a curriculum based on the language needed for learning the particular content.

Content-based instruction is based on the rationale that "people learn a second language more successfully when they use the language as a means of acquiring information, rather than as an end in itself" (Richards & Rodgers, 2001, p. 207). Krashen (1981) posits that students acquire language when they are exposed to "comprehensible input."

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This method was the most common way of learning languages for centuries and is still used in many situations and countries. The Grammar-Translation method of teaching English as a second language focuses mostly on teaching students about the language but not how to use it practically.

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
