**FP5004 Continuing Professional Development Policy**

You must have undertaken 35 hours of continuing professional development (CPD) relevant to your scope of practice as a nurse, midwife, nursing associate or combination in the three year period since your registration was last renewed, or when you joined the register. Of those 35 hours of CPD, at least 20 must have included participatory learning.
