Full Cost Accounting for Municipal Solid Waste Management ...

In comparing the costs of various solid waste management options (e.g., recycling vs. disposal), it is important that governments distinguish between "fixed" or "sunk" costs (i.e., costs that cannot immediately be avoided by selecting an alternative method of solid waste management) and "variable" costs.

Municipal Solid Waste Management and Full-Cost Accounting

Based on projected waste export costs of \$94 per ton (\$0.05 per pound) in fiscal year 2014, the cost of waste export and disposal for an average household is \$80 per year and \$7 per month. [56]
Hypothetically, the City could charge \$1.50 for each 30-gallon bag and \$0.75 for each 15-gallon bag.
