When this fuel mixes with hot, compressed air, combustion takes place. This is unlike gas engines, where combustion is caused by an electrical spark.

The fuel supply system of a diesel engine can be called as the heart of the engine, since the engine performance directly depends upon the proper functioning of this system—which must supply, meter, inject and atomize the fuel. Fuel injection systems are manufactured with great accuracy, hence they are costlier.

Diesel engine fuel-injection systems are typically designed to provide injection pressures in the range of 7 to 70 megapascals (1,000 to 10,000 pounds per square inch). There are, however, a few higher-pressure systems. Precise control of fuel injection is critical to the performance of a diesel engine.

Diesel Fuel Injection. One big difference between a diesel engine and a gas engine is in the injection process. Most car engines use port injection or a carburetor. A port injection system injects fuel just prior to the intake stroke (outside the cylinder). A carburetor mixes air and fuel long before the air enters the cylinder.

Diesel engines rely on the air/fuel mixing being done in the cylinder, which means they need a fuel injection system. The fuel is injected directly into the combustion chamber, which can be either a segmented combustion chamber, known as indirect injection (IDI), or an unsegmented combustion chamber, known as direct injection (DI). Most of the potential problems in a modern common rail diesel system engine can be explained by a drop in fuel pressure or engine compression, insufficient fuel supply, or fuel contamination. The major culprits are likely to be the fuel injectors, high pressure pump, fuel filter, fuel pressure sensor or regulator, glowplugs, or crankshaft sensor.

Exhaust system blocked or restricted. Engine condition causing low compression pressure. Diesel injection pump not delivering fuel Engine Starts then stops within a few seconds: Restricted fuel supply. Check fuel tank, pipes and filters. Air entering fuel system. Immobiliser fault. Faulty or incorrect ESOS (engine stop solenoid) or ELAP.

There are two faults that could be causing this, diesel injectors or diesel injector rail not holding the fuel within the system and poor fuel supply to the diesel injectors or diesel injector rail.

Accurate and repeatable fuel metering to the combustion chamber is critical to ensure that the diesel engine operates reliably and meets all the needs of the customer and engine manufacturer. Fuel can be metered in real-time (i.e., while it is being injected into the engine) or it can pre-metered before the injection process begins.
