Lightly dampen the loose edge or seam. This step softens the adhesive. Lift the loose edge. Raise the lifted edge with a knife. Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy.

To repair wallpaper joints with seam glue, use a small artist's brush to spread the glue on the back of the wallpaper, then wait for the adhesive to soften and reactivate the old wallpaper paste. When the area is tacky to the touch, gently push the seams back down using a damp cloth. Don't use a seam roller, since it will just force the glue back out.

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

A simple fix for loose wallpaper... or "Sometimes, you just get lucky!" Apply a little seam sealer onto the wall or the paper. Don't apply too much, especially with a "paper" wallpaper. Press the paper in place. Wipe off any excess sealer with a damp sponge and... Voila!... job well done!

We overlapped the two adjacent sheets, and now we will cut both of them to make our new seam here. Basically, double cutting is overlapping the paper and then cutting through both layers at the same time to perfectly match the edges. Try and stay as straight as you can.

Apply blue painter's tape to seams that continue to curl even after they are re-glued. After all the adhesive is wiped from the wallpaper's surface, place tape over the seam, starting at both ends...

When you notice gaps between your wallpaper seams, you can use paint a color that is similar to the one on the wallpaper and cover small gaps. This only works for small gaps, but it is far simpler and less potentially damaging than re-doing the wallpaper. If the gaps are too big, you will probably want to try to re-apply the wallpaper.

OPEN SEAMS- POOR JOINS: OH Dear...not good. Opening or poor seams occur when the seams of the wallpaper spring or open during the drying process. This can be as little as part of 1 millimeter, to 1 or 2 millimeters. THERE IS NOTHING IN ANY WALLCOVERING THAT WILL MAKE OR CAUSE THE SEAMS TO OPEN.

Fill a glue syringe with wallpaper seam adhesive. Choose a syringe with a small tip, like a 21 gauge, so it won't leave a mark in your paper. Remove the plunger from the end and squeeze the adhesive directly into the body of the syringe. Then replace the plunger before using.

Use a sharp utility knife and straightedge to cut the wallpaper. To make a patch, cut a square larger than the existing area to be patched and align the pattern. Use masking tape or tacks to attach the patch to the wall. Cut through the patch and the wallpaper with a utility knife and straightedge as shown at left.

Overworking the paper stretches it, and when the paper returns to its normal expanded size, the seam will open. You might also tear the wallcovering. Use a seam roller to seal the seam. Be firm but don't press so hard that you roll out all the adhesive.

To avoid ragged cuts, put a new blade in your knife. Double-cut through both the new patch and old wallpaper (Photo 2). Remove the patch and carefully scrape off the old wallpaper. If you nick the wall surface when scraping off the old paper, fill the nicks with joint compound and sand the repairs flat.
