In low malaria endemic areas, in addition to ACT, all individuals (except in children < 30 kg, pregnant women or breastfeeding women of infants aged < 6 months) diagnosed with P. falciparum malaria, should be given a single dose of 0.25 mg/kg primaquine to reduce the risk of transmission. 3

acquiring malaria than short term travellers to the same location. Furthermore, once infected, the risk of developing severe or complicated malaria is higher in certain groups, such as the elderly (over 70 years old), the immunosuppressed, those with complex co-morbidities and pregnant women.

Diagnosis – Travellers who develop a fever of 38 ° C [100 ° F] or higher more than one week after being in a malaria risk area, or who develop any symptoms suggestive of malaria within a year of return should seek immediate medical care. Emergency standby treatment may be considered for those going to remote areas with limited access to medical attention.

potentially fatal disease (especially when caused by *Plasmodium falciparum*), and treatment should be initiated as soon as possible. Which drug regimen to treat a patient with malaria depends on the clinical status of the patient, the type (species) of the infecting parasite, the area where the infection was acquired and its drug-resistance status, pregnancy status, and finally history of drug allergies, or other medications taken by the patient.
