Moons in our Solar System As of October 2008, there are 213 known natural moons orbiting planets in our Solar System. 205 moons orbit the "full-size" planets (Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune), while 8 moons orbit the smaller "dwarf planets" (Ceres, Pluto, Haumea, Makemake, and Eris).

Other big moons and the planets they orbit in include, the Earth's Moon (3,475km), Jupiter's Europa (3,122km), Neptune's Triton (2,707km), Uranus's Titania (1,578km), Saturn's Rhea (1,529km) and Uranus's Oberon (1,523km). Most of the observations on these moons are done from the ground.

The Solar System's planets, and its most likely dwarf planets, are known to be orbited by at least 218 natural satellites, or moons. 19 of them are large enough to be gravitationally rounded; of these, all are covered by a crust of ice except for Earth's Moon and Io. Several of the largest ones are in hydrostatic equilibrium and would therefore be considered dwarf planets or planets if they were in direct orbit around the Sun and not in their current states. The Solar System is the gravitationally bound system of the Sun and the objects that orbit it, either directly or indirectly. Of the objects that orbit the Sun directly, the largest are the eight planets, with the remainder being smaller objects, the dwarf planets and small Solar System bodies.
