Baggage must not be left unattended. Guests must not make noise after 10 p.m. We use mustn't particularly when the prohibition comes from the speaker.

There is a BIG difference in meaning between Mustn't and Don't have to. Mustn't means something is prohibited or it is not allowed. It is important that you do NOT do something. Don't have to means there is NO obligation to do something. You are not required to do something, especially if you don't want to.

While meaning is generally maintained in incorrect usage in the positive forms, a mix-up in the negative forms can cause confusion. Only have to has a past and a future form. Must does not have a past or a future form. Yesterday, I had to take a taxi. (NOT Yesterday, I must take a taxi)

have to, don't have to, must, mustn't – Test-English

must/mustn't, have to/don't have to – form . must/mustn't . Use must + infinitive without to. Must is a modal verb, and modal verbs are followed by infinitive without to.. I must go to the doctor. (NOT I must to go to the doctor.; No -s. Modal verbs don't add -s after he/she/it.. He must come with us. (NOT He must comes with us.; Use must/mustn't in negatives and questions

MUST and HAVE TO are both used to express an obligation, responsibility or necessity. While Must can generally be replaced by Have to in the present tense, there is sometimes a slight difference in meaning or use. Let's look at our previous example using MUST: I must write a letter to John.
