### New Born Baby Formula Feeding

After one month your baby's stomach is about the size of a large egg, with a capacity of 80-150 millilitres. From after the first week until around 6 months old (when your baby starts weaning ), your little one may need around 150 to 200 millilitres of formula milk a day for every kilogram of body weight.

### Formula Feeding Guide - How Much Should Your Baby Eat ...

Newborn babies need quite small amounts of formula to start with. By the end of their first week, most will need around 150 to 200ml per kilo of their weight a day until they're 6 months old. This amount will vary from baby to baby. Although most babies settle into a feeding pattern eventually, they vary in how often they want to feed and how much they want to drink.

Hold and cuddle your baby as much as possible, ideally skin to skin. This will encourage your body to make milk and your baby to feed. Express your breast milk regularly . Expressing releases the hormone prolactin, which stimulates your breasts to make milk. About 8 times a day, including once at night is ideal.
