A non-chronological report is a non-fiction report which is not written in time order. All of the following information texts are written in time order: Explanation - this is a text about a process which happens or happened in a certain order, such as the water cycle or the events of a battle. Recount - this is a time ordered re-telling of something that has happened in real life, such as a school trip or the life of Gandhi.

A non-chronological report is a piece of non-fiction text that is not written in time order, otherwise referred to as chronologically. Things like instructions, recounts and explanations are usually written chronologically (in time order). For example, a recount re-tells something that has happened, so it makes sense to be written chronologically. Just like other conclusions in other forms of writing, you are limited with the kind of information you include here. For one, no new information, facts, or evidence that has not been discussed in the report is supposed to be introduced in the concluding paragraph.
