Setting up Power of Attorney - Which?

An enduring power of attorney is effective for the purposes of the Transfer of Land Act 1893 (TLA) (and Property Law Act 1969) as if it were in the form provided for by s.143 of the TLA. The GA Act specifies any 'person' of 18 years or over may appoint an attorney to manage their personal affairs and finances.
