Posttraumatic Stress Disorder. PTSD is a disabling psychosocial disorder that follows a traumatic or overwhelming experience. Population studies estimate that exposure to at least one traumatic event is experienced by 14% to 43% of children and adolescents (U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, 2010). The development of PTSD is correlated to severity of trauma, proximity, repeated experience of trauma, and social supports.

Approximately about 18% of people ages 18- 54 in a given year, have an anxiety disorder in a given year. Anxiety disorders include: panic disorder, obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), generalized anxiety disorder (GAD), and phobias (social phobia, agoraphobia, and specific phobia).

Mental health statistics: children and young people We take a life-course approach to mental health because good mental health begins in infancy. 20% of adolescents may experience a mental health problem in any given year. 1 50% of mental health problems are established by age 14 and 75% by age 24. 2

The specific causes of psychological disorders are not known, but contributing factors may include chemical imbalances in the brain, childhood experiences, heredity, illnesses, prenatal exposures, and stress. Some disorders, such as borderline personality and depression, occur more frequently in women.

Psychosocial support is an important component of treatment. Schizophrenia and other psychoses Schizophrenia is a severe mental disorder, affecting 20 million people worldwide 1. Psychoses, including schizophrenia, are characterized by distortions in thinking, perception, emotions, language, sense of self and behaviour.

The physical and psychosocial health of people who have communication disorders are considered a vulnerable population. Globally, in 2015, there were 500 million people with hearing loss, which equates to 6.8% of the world's population. In the US, 15% of the population have hearing loss, and up to 50% of elderly >70 years of age (Sher, para 2, 2020). ...

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
