To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

To cite a direct quote in APA, you must include the author ' s last name, the year, and a page number, all separated by commas. If the quote appears on a single page, use " p. " ; if it spans a page range, use " pp. " An APA in-text citation can be parenthetical or narrative.

The final period or comma goes inside the quotation marks, even if it is not a part of the quoted material, unless the quotation is followed by a citation. If a citation in parentheses follows the quotation, the period follows the citation. If a superscript footnote number is used, it follows the period and the quotation marks.

Quotations must be identical to the original, using a narrow segment of the source. They must match the source document word for word and must be attributed to the original author. Paraphrasing involves putting a passage from source material into your own words. A paraphrase must also be attributed to the original source.

When paraphrasing or summarizing a web page, the citation should include the author last name and date listed on the web page or at the bottom of the website.. If you are using a quote, you will also need to include the page number.If there are no page numbers, include the most direct location of the quote, such as a section title and/or a paragraph number.

Quotation marks (also known as speech marks, quotes or inverted commas) are used to set off direct speech and quotations. In academic writing, you need to use quotation marks when you quote a source. This includes quotes from published works and primary data such as interviews.

**How to Use Quotation Marks (") in Academic Writing**

Put the title in quotation marks. Quotation marks enclose titles of smaller works or parts of a whole. Set the title off from the rest of the writing with italic or underlining. By using italic or underlining, you set off titles of larger works or complete works.

**When to Put Titles in Quotation Marks**—dummies

Place the quoted words in the writing, and then put a parenthesis with the citation. MLA format citations put the author ' s name and the page from which the quote was taken. APA format citations put the author ' s name and the date of the publication, instead. Add a Bibliography or Works Cited page after the paper.

Format quotations of 40 words or more as block quotations: Do not use quotation marks to enclose a block quotation. Start a block quotation on a new line and indent the whole block 0.5 in. from the left margin. Double-space the entire block quotation.
