As children spend a large part of their time at school, one important venue to reach large numbers of children and adolescents is through prevention programmes that are offered at schools.

School-based programmes to reduce and prevent substance ...

The KiVa program includes an anti-bullying computer game at the elementary school level. When examining studies among schools who utilized the KiVa program (intervention group), compared to those who did not (control group), a substantial decrease was noted in the area of self-reported peer victimization for the intervention group. The KiVa intervention program also decreased peer-reported bullying for the intervention group, although this effect did not reach statistical significance.
