The Plumbat Affair – Military Melbourne

On November 17, 1968, a shabby cargo ship, the Scheersberg A, was loaded with 560 metal drums (meaningless labeled "Plumbat") and sailed out of Antwerp, bound for Genoa, Italy--and vanished. Over two weeks later the ship arrived at the Turkish port of Iskenderum, quite empty, and was promptly abandoned by captain and crew.
