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The first compound steam turbine of 10 horse power (page 7) ran at 18,000 revolutions per minute, and had slightly elastic bearings to allow it to rotate about its dynamic or principal axis. The turbine teeth or blades were like a cog wheel, set at an angle and sharpened at the front edges, and the guide blades were similar.
